Following the circuit court's granting of the State's petition to revoke Scotty Bernard Ballard's probation, Ballard's counsel filed on appeal a motion to withdraw on the ground that this appeal is wholly without merit along with a supporting brief. While Ballard was provided with a copy of the brief and notified that he could file a list of pro se points within thirty days, he did not do so. After reviewing the record and counsel's brief, we hold that counsel has filed a complying brief and that this appeal is wholly without merit. *See Anders v. California*, 386 U.S. 738 (1967); Ark. Sup. Ct. R. 4-3(k) (2011). Accordingly, we grant the motion to withdraw and affirm the circuit court's decision.

Affirmed; motion to withdraw granted.
