APPEAL & ERROR — MOTION FOR RULE ON CLERK — GOOD CAUSE FOR GRANTING. — Where an attorney for a criminal defendant admits that the order extending time for filing the record was entered late due to a mistake on his part, such an error is good cause to grant a motion for rule on the clerk.

Motion for Rule on Clerk; granted.

PER CURIAM. Appellant Arley David Mathis, by and through his attorney, has filed a motion for rule on clerk. His attorney, Robert Scott Parks, states in the motion that the order extending time for filing the record was entered late due to a mistake on his part.
