Petitioner's pro se fifth motion to reinvest jurisdiction in the trial court to consider a petition for writ of error coram nobis; motion for appointment of counsel; and motion for leave to reply to State's response to motion to reinvest jurisdiction in the trial court to consider a petition for writ of error coram nobis. Petition denied; motion to file reply granted; motion to appoint counsel moot.
