[CR-24-646](#). State of Arkansas v. Ronald Russell, from Benton County Circuit Court. Appellee's motion to dismiss appeal. Motion granted; appeal dismissed. Wood and Womack, JJ., and Special Justice Troy Braswell concur. Bronni, J., not participating.

[CR-25-66](#). Aaron Spencer v. State of Arkansas, from Lonoke County Circuit Court. Petition for writ of certiorari to the Lonoke County Circuit Court. Petition for writ of certiorari granted; writ issued; circuit court's gag order vacated. Wood, Womack, Hiland, and Bronni, JJ., concur.

Special Justice Barbara Halsey joins. Bronni, J., not participating.

CODY HILAND, JUSTICE
